

## Scholarship Information

### **Kochville Township Firefighters Association Scholarship**

#### **INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES**

- 1) Amount of scholarship – Up to three \$500.00 scholarships given annually.
- 2) The scholarship will be given to:
  - a. Any high school graduate or G.E.D. equivalent who resides within Kochville Township.
  - b. Any child or grandchild from a Kochville Township active or retired firefighter in good standing.
  - c. First consideration will be given to those entering an emergency services field.
  - d. All information submitted will be considered confidential.

#### **CRITERIA FOR SELECTION**

1. The candidate must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
2. Financial need may be a consideration.
3. Individual interviews may be conducted with each of the final candidates by the selection committee.
4. Two letters of recommendation; letters from emergency service personnel are encouraged, and at least one from a High School Representative.
5. A copy of the most current transcript must be included.
6. The recipient must be pursuing or planning to pursue undergraduate, graduate, or job skills at an accredited university, college or a recognized trade school.

Before receiving funds from the Kochville Township Firefighters Association students must present proof that they are registered at an accredited university, college or a recognized trade school.

The scholarship committee will consider all information confidential.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE**

The selection committee will consist of the executive board of the Kochville Township Fire Association.

Applications must be received by January 31<sup>st</sup> of each year, and return to the Kochville Township Fire Association.

Scholarships will be award at our annual spring fling awards dinner to no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>.
